The IDCMR Scholarships 2019

Postgraduate Program IDCMR (Academic year 2020)

In order to develop the oral health resource capacity among the Mekong River Region countries according to the MOU of IDCMR, to promote cooperation in training, education and collaborative researches, the following activities are announced.

Programs offered for Academic Year 2020: (Program starts in August 2020)

Doctor of Philosophy Programs (International program)

- Doctor of Philosophy Program in Dental Biomaterials Science
- Doctor of Philosophy Program in Oral Biology and Integrative Biomedical Science

Master of Science Programs (International program)

- Master of Science Program in Oral Biology and Integrative Biomedical Science
- Master of Science Program in Dentistry (major in):
 - Community Dentistry
 - Advanced General Dentistry
 - Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery
 - Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology
 - Pediatric Dentistry

Eligibility Requirements:

Candidates for a Doctoral or Master Program must

- 1. Be current faculty members of the International Dental Collaboration of the Mekong River Region institutions.
- 2. Have never received any Postgraduate Program IDCMR Scholarship
- 3. Be qualified as the requirement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Program requirement of the Mahidol University.
- 4. Have a good command of written and spoken English with a standardized test
 - Doctoral Program: minimum English Proficiency score of TOEFL: ITP 500, IBT 61, or IELTS: 5
 - Master Program: minimum English Proficiency score of TOEFL: ITP 480, IBT 54, or IELTS: 5

Postgraduate Program IDCMR (Academic year 2020) Details:

- 1. Monthly allowance (for accommodation fees and expenses) 15,000 baht per month
- 2. Traveling Expense: A one-time travel allowance for 20,000 baht (Economy class)
- 3. Tuition Fee

This scholarship does not provide financial assistance towards payment of tuition fees; however, Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University will exempt students from tuition fees.

- 4. The terms of payment will be made based on duration of the program in which recipients enroll:
 - 4.1 Doctoral Program at Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University, scholarship will be awarded to the scholar for 24, 36 or 48 months according to the minimum duration stated in study plan of each program.
 - 4.2 Master's program at Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University, scholarship will be awarded to the scholar for 24 months.
 - 4.3 The scholarship will be valid only 24, 36 and 48 months according to study plan. In case of extension the student may continue with their own expenses.

5. IDCMR scholars are required to have their research(s) or part of their research(s) published in a well-accepted peer-review scientific journal* meeting the criteria of graduation requirement of Mahidol University Faculty of Graduate Studies.

* International journals appear in Web of Science databases, Scopus databases, or domestically published peer-review journals of international quality listed in Academic Information section of graduate studies website

Remark: Publication and presentation resulting from this IDCMR scholarship must include an acknowledgment of the Mahidol University Faculty of Dentistry support

Announcement of the results: June 28, 2019

Documents to be submitted:

- 1. Completed application form with statement of purpose (Form 3), the form can be downloaded from the website at *https://dt.mahidol.ac.th* (*English version*)
- 2. Two recommendation letters from the Dean and Department Chair of the institution where candidates are studying/working for
- 3. Valid English Proficiency Test score (within 2 years) For Doctoral Program: TOEFL: ITP 500, IBT, 61 or IELTS: 5 For Master Program: TOEFL: ITP 480, IBT, 54 or IELTS: 5
- 4. A brief research proposal

Selection Process:

1. Candidates will be selected on a basis of submitted materials, the English proficiency and research proposal. Written test and a long-distance interview via phone call or Skype may be requested in some programs.

2. Program administrative board will screen potential candidates including written test result and interview if required and propose the result to the selection committee. After that, the Selection Committee consisting of Dean and Deputy Deans will make a final decision.

Notification of Selection Results:

Letter of acceptance will be issued to the accepted applicants to the address written on their application forms and also to the deans of the applicants' institutes.
