Professor Samaranayake is the Vice-Dean of Sharjah University College of Dental Medicine and immediate-past Head, and Professor of Oral Microbiomics at the University of Queensland, School of Dentistry. He has held teaching and consultant positions at the University of Glasgow, UK, University of Alberta, Canada and the University of Peradeniya, Sri Lanka and served as a Director of the FDI World Dental Federation and the Chairman of its Science Commission. The author of over 400 research articles, with an h-index of 77, Professor Samaranayake has been cited in the literature, over 21,500 times. He has won numerous accolades for his research including the IADR Distinguished Scientist Award in Oral Medicine and Pathology as well as the King James IV Professorship of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, UK.
