**Mahidol University Faculty of Dentistry Announcement**

**Policy of not accepting gifts and all kinds of rewards for performing duties (No Gift Policy)**

**For the fiscal year B.E. 2567 (2024)**

In alignment with the national reform plan in the areas of prevention and suppression of corruption and misconduct, with a particular emphasis on developing a policy of not accepting gifts and all kinds of rewards for performing duties (No Gift Policy) of the Office of Public Sector Anti-Corruption Commission (PACC),

Mahidol University Faculty of Dentistry hereby declares the following to concretely promote the No Gift Policy:

- 1) Mahidol University Faculty of Dentistry announces to “declare themselves as units where every state official refuses to accept gifts and rewards of any kind before, during, or after executing their duties, to prevent corruption and malpractice.
- 2) Mahidol University Faculty of Dentistry delineates its policy or guidelines regarding the No Gift Policy for faculty personnel as follows:
  - 2.1 Declines to accept or present any gratuities, incentives, or remunerations of any nature from individuals, institutions, public corporations, or entities currently or previously affiliated with government procurement activities within the jurisdiction of Mahidol University Faculty of Dentistry.
  - 2.2 Prohibition from soliciting or engaging in any actions to induce others to provide gifts, presents, or benefits that contravene the regulations of the No Gift Policy.
  - 2.3 Consider the appropriateness of giving or receiving gifts in line with prevailing customs, culture, traditions, or norms of etiquette. The value of these gifts must not exceed 3,000 baht or exceed the legal limit. It is important not to undervalue the gifts.
  - 2.4 Recommendation of utilizing greeting cards, books, or social media platforms to convey goodwill, welcome, or condolences as per customary practices.

- 3) All Executives, Unit heads, or commanding officers at every level are responsible for communicating this policy to all personnel, ensuring strict adherence to these guidelines moving forward.

Please be informed and comply accordingly.
