Endodontics Clinic



Get to know the clinic:

We specialize in non-surgical and surgical root canal treatments, which are carried out by our team of experienced endodontists, endodontic faculty, and postgraduate students in the Master of Science and residency training programs. Our treatments are performed using modern endodontic equipment, including rotary instruments, and are conducted under dental microscopes to ensure precision and accuracy.

What dental services are provided?

We offer two different service systems: the Education Service System (Office Hours Clinic) and the Self-support Service System (After Hours Clinic). Both systems provide a wide range of endodontic treatments, such as endodontic diagnosis and treatment planning, vital pulp therapy, emergency treatment of pulpal pain, root canal treatments, and non-surgical and surgical root canal treatments.

Education Service System (Office Hours Clinic)

Our Education Service System is exclusively provided by postgraduate students in Endodontics. The service is available from Monday to Friday, from 08.30-16.30 hrs., except on Wednesday afternoons and public holidays.





Self-support Service System (After Hours Clinic)

The Self-support Service System provides endodontic services administered by a team of experienced endodontic specialists and postgraduate students. Our services cover a wide range of treatment options, from general to advanced levels, and are available to both registered patients and those referred from other clinics or hospitals.

Consultation and Treatment Planning for Endodontic Diseases

In addition to our primary services, the Endodontics Clinic offers consultation and treatment planning for endodontic diseases to dentists in various fields. As the Mahidol Dental Microscope Center, we provide clinical training in complex endodontic procedures, such as treating calcified canals, removing separated instruments, and performing non-surgical as well as surgical root canal retreatment.

Scope of services

Our scope of services includes conventional root canal treatments, non-surgical and surgical root canal retreatments, and the management of complex treatment conditions, such as root canal anomalies, root resorption, and iatrogenic perforations. We also offer a range of trauma treatments, including root canal therapy, splinting, and tooth restoration, to help restore damaged teeth to their optimal function and appearance. Our team works closely with other dental professionals, including oral surgeons, periodontists, and prosthodontists, to ensure the best possible outcome for our patients.

Dr. Justin Lu, a Taiwanese final-year dental student (at the time of this visit, currently a general dentist) from CEU San Pablo University, Madrid, Spain, visited our dental school during February 20-24, 2023 for a short-term exchange program as he took part in clinical observation at the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Clinic and Surgery Unit.

The student gave an interview with us and you can read what he had to say here:

1. Why did you decide to participate in a short-term exchange program here?

Mahidol University Faculty of Dentistry is the leading medical and dental center in Thailand and South East Asia. It was my honor to be one of the short-term family members of the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (OMFS) Department. One day, I saw the article of Asst. Prof. Yutthasak Kriangcherdsak (Head of the OMFS department) about the success rate of nerve block. This impressed me very much and made me want to visit the Faculty of Dentistry at Mahidol University.

2. Tell us about your impressions of the time spent at Mahidol dental hospital. How do you think it was useful for you?

Starting with a morning meeting, all the OMFS members impressed me with their presentation skills and group discussion. After that, in the surgery room, everyone was friendly and their skills are perfect, plus they do not hesitate to answer any of my questions. Last but not least, Mr. Wasin (International Relations officer) gave me a lot of help and he is my best friend these days.

3. What are the differences you see between the way dentistry is practiced here and in your country?

I practiced in Spain, Germany, and Switzerland, and I think the difference is that Thai people are so friendly and willing to teach me and explain a lot of things. I used to think that Thailand is a developing country, but I can guarantee that OMFS here is not worse but even better than many places in Europe.

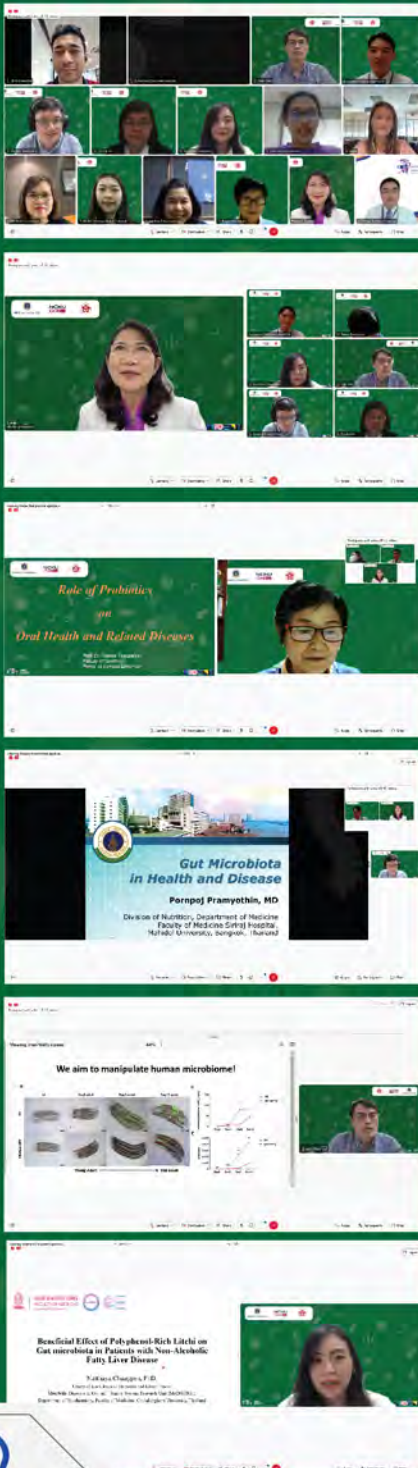
4. What would you recommend to those interested in an exchange program here and why?

OMFS of Mahidol University operates a lot of orthognathic surgery a day. In addition to that, as a high-level center university hospital, they provide students with many opportunities to discuss and practice with their teachers. Oral Health Problems in the Elderly: Tooth Decay

Causes:

- Acid-producing bacteria and plaque which could potentially destroy the enamel and dentin layer
- Receding gums caused by periodontitis which leads to root decay

Prevention:

- Rinse your mouth every time after meals and brush your teeth at least twice a day with fluoride toothpaste (for the frail elderly, caregivers could use wet gauze to wipe the gum to keep away food particles from building up in the mouth).
- Use cleaning tools such as dental floss and interdental brush.
- Rinse your mouth with a fluoride mouthwash.



Closing Gaps Between Teeth

Teeth Gap Treatment

Closing teeth gaps could begin with diagnosing the causes and fixing them with appropriate treatments as follows:

Orthodontic Braces

Braces with wires and brackets to slowly move the teeth together and close the gaps.

Dental Restoration

Composite resin restoration or dental veneers.

Follow-Up Treatment and Behavioral Modification

Follow-up treatment and behavioral modification of self-oral health care (oral behavior causing teeth gaps such as tongue thrusting).

Operation

If the gaps are caused by connective tissue disorder, an operation combined with other procedures may be required.

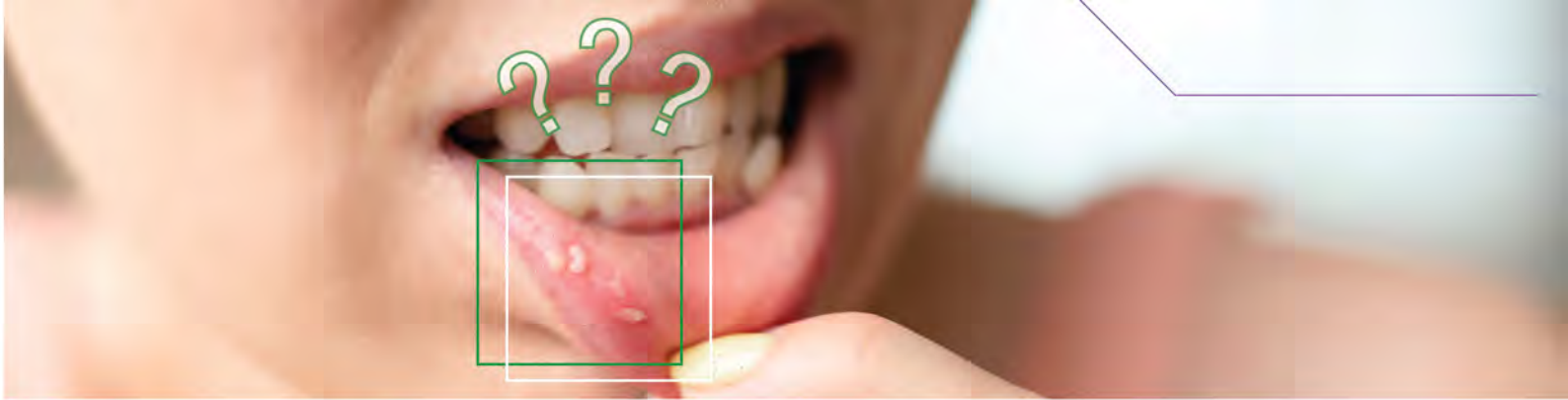
Teeth Replacement

If the gaps get too large, teeth replacement may need to be considered.

Post-Treatment Care

- : Brush and floss the teeth regularly*
- : If the treatment is by composite resin restoration or dental veneers, chewing hard and sticky food should be avoided as those materials are more prone to breaking than regular teeth*
