**Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University Announcement
on Student Admission to Doctor of Dental Surgery Program
(International Program), Faculty of Dentistry
Direct Admission by the Faculty, Academic Year 2026**

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Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University, is now accepting applications for the Direct Admission by the Faculty, Academic Year 2026 to the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program). Pursuant to Section 37 of the Mahidol University Act, B.E. 2550 (2007), the Dean, with the concurrence of the Faculty of Dentistry Board at Meeting No. 9/2568 convened on 4th September 2025. The details of the Student Admission are hereby announced as follows:

1. Enrollment capacity: 30 students

- 1.1 Group 1: 27 students from schools in Thailand and/or overseas.
- 1.2 Group 2: 3 students from Mahidol University International Demonstration School.

Remarks: If the number of students from Group 2 is not fulfilled, applicants on the waiting list in Group 1 will be called to complete a total of 30.

2. Admission requirements

2.1 General eligibility requirements

- 2.1.1 Applicants must be at least 16 years of age as at the start date of the first semester of the academic year 2026.
- 2.1.2 Non-Thai applicants must have a passport of the country in which the applicant holds citizenship. The passport must be valid for six months beyond the last day of the application period. Applicants must be prepared to obtain a visa to enter Thailand for interviews and medical clearance at the given date and time.
- 2.1.3 Applicants must not be eligible for admission or have confirmed their admission through the TCAS system for the Academic Year 2026, and must not be currently enrolled in any Doctor of Dental Surgery program at any institution. Mahidol University will verify the admission confirmation status through the system of the Council of University Presidents of Thailand.

2.1.4 Applicants.../-2-

- 2.1.4 Applicants must be in good behavior and certify to Mahidol University that intend to study to the best of their abilities and will follow the rules and regulations of Mahidol University that already exist and/or that will continue to be strictly in all respects.
- 2.1.5 Applicants must have the person who will subsidize the tuition fees and various expenses related to studying until the completion of the program.
- 2.1.6 Applicants must be healthy and free from the following diseases, symptoms, or physical deformities that hinder the study and practice of dentistry:
 - 2.1.6.1 Serious psychiatric problems that may be harmful to oneself and/or others include psychotic disorders, mood disorders, personality disorders (antisocial personality disorders or borderline personality disorders types), and other psychotic disorders.
 - 2.1.6.2 Communicable diseases within an active condition that could harm oneself, patients, or could result in permanent disability.
 - 2.1.6.3 Have non - communicable diseases or conditions that could harm oneself and/or others and could be an obstacle to the study and practice of dentistry.
 - 2.1.6.4 Physical deformities that could be an obstacle to the study and practice of dentistry.
 - 2.1.6.5 Hearing impairment of both ears with a hearing threshold higher than 40 decibels at 500 - 2000 Hz. frequency and speech discrimination score less than 70 percent of sensorineural hearing loss.
 - 2.1.6.6 Visual impairment with the best eye when corrected with glasses has visual acuity less than 6/12 or 20/40.
 - 2.1.6.7 Total color blindness that could be an obstacle to the study and practice of dentistry.
 - 2.1.6.8 Other illnesses or disabilities not specified here but could be an obstacle to the study and practice of dentistry.

Remarks: For the diseases, symptoms, or physical deformities given in Clause 2.1.6, the judgment is under the discretion of Mahidol International Dental School (MIDS) Admission Committee for the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program) Academic Year 2026 and considered as final.

2.2 Specific qualifications of Group 1, students from schools in Thailand and overseas

2.2.1 Educational qualifications:

2.2.1.1 Studying or graduating from Thai High Schools (M.6).

OR Studying or graduating from International High Schools Grade 12 in the American system OR Year 13 in the English system.

OR Studying or obtaining a certificate equivalent to the criteria set by the Ministry of Education according to the Ministry of Education regulations regarding the comparison of domestic and foreign educational qualifications at the level of basic education B.E. 2563.

2.2.1.2 There must be 3 science - mathematics subjects in the high school transcripts including; 1) Chemistry, 2) Biology, 3) Physics or Mathematics.

A GED (General Educational Development)/ IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education), or any other equivalent qualification cannot be used to apply for this program.

2.2.2 Test scores are as follows:

2.2.2.1 For applicants who are studying or graduating from Thai High Schools (M.6).

OR Studying or graduating from International High Schools Grade 12 in the American system.

OR Studying or graduating from International High Schools Year 13 in the English system.

OR Studying or having graduated from an overseas school.

Submit a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of 3.00 or higher.

2.2.2.2 Any one of the following examination results (If any)

1) A total score of IB Diploma is greater than or equal to 35 points out of 45 points.

OR Applicants in their final year with a predicted IB score of 35 points or higher out of a total of 45 points.

2) A total score of International A Level is greater than or equal to ABB in the science - mathematics subjects, with at least 3 from 4 subjects: 1) Chemistry 2) Biology 3) Physics OR Mathematics.

OR Applicants in their final year with predicted International A Level is greater than or equal to ABB in the science - mathematics subjects at least 3 from 4 subjects: 1) Chemistry 2) Biology 3) Physics OR Mathematics.

- 3) Advanced Placement Subject Tests (AP)
Chemistry with a score of 4 or higher
Biology with a score of 4 or higher
Calculus AB OR Calculus BC OR Physics 1- Algebra Based with a score of 4 or higher

Remarks: Applicants who are graduates or current students in the final year of high school with other foreign curriculums could also apply. Consideration and approval will be under the discretion of MIDS Admission Committees for the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program) Academic Year 2026.

2.3 Specific qualifications of Group 2, students from Mahidol University International Demonstration School.

- 2.3.1 Currently studying in the final year of high school (Grade 12) which is expected to graduate in the academic year 2025.
- 2.3.2 Must be nominated by an International Demonstration School, Mahidol University.
- 2.3.3 Have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) greater than or equal to 3.50.
- 2.3.4 Have at least 2 “A” in 4 following subjects* which are shown in the high school transcript; 1) Chemistry 2) Biology 3) Physics and 4) Mathematics.

***Excluding Advanced Placement Courses or AP Courses.**

2.4 Standardized test scores for the students from Groups 1 and 2 are as follows:

- 2.4.1 International standardized test scores
The University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT)
OR Thai Biomedical Admissions Test (TBAT)
no minimum score
- 2.4.2 English language standardized test scores
TOEFL Internet-based (TOEFL - iBT) **score of 79 or higher**
OR IELTS Academic Test **score of 6.5 or higher**

All of the test from item 2.4 must be no more than 2 years, counted from the date of the score report to the final date of application (Friday, November 21, 2025).

3. Application process and required document

- 3.1 Study the details in the admission announcement (Please study the information by yourself for the benefit of applicants).

3.3 Upload all application documents as follows:

- 3.3.1 A 1.5 x 2-inch, straight-faced photo, wearing a school uniform/ formal outfit (no hat, no sunglasses) with a white or a blue background. The photo must be taken within 6 months and not digitally modified and scanned as .jpeg file, the file size not more than 1 MB.
- 3.3.2 The application form must be filled out completely as required and signed with a blue ink pen and scanned to .pdf file, file size not more than 5 MB.
- 3.3.3 A photocopy of the identification card (use only the front) OR a photocopy of the passport must be copied on A4-size paper. Also, the applicant's signature on these two documents must be signed with a blue ink pen and scanned to .pdf file, file size not more than 5 MB. In case the applicant's name or last name presented on the ID card or the passport does not match with other documents. The applicant must have a certified copy of name change and must sign with a blue ink pen and scan to .pdf file, then save it all documents as one .pdf file.
- 3.3.4 A photocopy of the house registration for Thai applicants OR a photocopy of proof of residence in Thailand for non - Thai applicants must be copied on A4 size paper. Also, the applicant's signature on these two documents must be signed with a blue ink pen and scanned to a .pdf file; the file size not more than 5 MB.
- 3.3.5 Academic documents must be copied on A4-size paper, and also the applicant's signature on these documents must be signed with a blue ink pen and scanned to a .pdf file. In case there are 2 pages, please scan both the front and the back. The file size does not exceed 5 MB, including:
 - 3.3.5.1 A certified copy of the graduation certificate issued by the educational institution, OR an official letter of student status certifying that the applicant is currently enrolled and expected to graduate in the academic year 2025.
 - 3.3.5.2 IB Diploma and International A Level student must attach a certified record showing the predicted IB Diploma score OR the predicted International A Level score.
 - 3.3.5.3 A photocopy of the official high school transcript.
- 3.3.6 The score reports of the standardized tests (2.4) must be copied on A4-size paper, and also the applicant's signature on these documents must be signed with a blue ink pen and scanned to a .pdf file; the file size does not exceed 5 MB. (In case there are 2 pages, please scan both the front and the back.)

3.3.7 The portfolio consists of the information as follows:

3.3.7.1 Choosing **ONLY ONE** topic from all 4 topics:

1) Academic 2) Art 3) Leadership OR 4) Social responsibility;

Presenting not more than 4 activities or works from the selected topic.

3.3.7.2 Presenting activities/works in English only.

3.3.7.3 Presenting activities/works in a vertical form with a size of A4 page, no animation, no video, no QR code, and should be saved as a .pdf file format.

3.3.7.4 Presenting all information in the portfolio only 6 pages, with details as follows:

1st page: A brief introduction of the applicant and a short of a chosen topic and the reasons for the topic selection.

2nd page: The statement of purpose should explain the reason and motivation for applying to study the Doctor of Dentistry (International Program) and life goals, at least 500 words, using Times New Roman, 12 font size, and single space.

3rd - 6th page: Photos of activities or works with a brief description.

3.3.8 The ORIGINAL bank receipt for the payment of the application fee must be scanned as .pdf file; the file size does not exceed 5 MB. The applicant must pay the application fee in the full amount of 3,500 baht, non-refundable, and must be paid at the bank only. (Online banking cannot be accepted.) The name of the depositor should be the applicant's name and last name. The application fee should be paid **by Friday, November 21, 2025, before 4:00 p.m.** MIDS does not cover any fees that may be charged by the bank or any currency conversion differences.

3.3.9 The applicant will be responsible for verifying the accuracy of all uploaded application documents before confirming the application information. Once the online application has been submitted, the applicant must print out the application form from the admission system and sign the applicant's name with a blue ink pen. The applicant will not be able to edit any information in the system by themselves. The applicant must notify the staff at the International School of Dentistry for any corrections.

3.4 Recommendation letters from 2 of the applicant's teachers, details as follows:

- 3.4.1 Should introduce and recommend the applicant to be accepted to the Doctor of Dentistry program (International Program).
- 3.4.2 Printed in English or Thai, not exceeding one A4 page, sealed, and affixed with the school seal.
- 3.4.3 Letters may be sent directly from the applicant's school to Mahidol International Dental School, OR applicants can submit the letters together with other application documents.

3.5 Applicants are required to submit all application documents by post OR by private courier service **during the period from Monday, November 10 to Friday, November 21, 2025, between 08:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.** (The date indicated by the official postal stamp will be regarded as the official submission date.)

- (1) The application will be completed only after the applicant has applied through the online admission system, paid the application fee in full, and submitted all application documents within a given date at Mahidol International Dental School, Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University.
 - (2) In case that there is an error due to the applicant or it is found that the application documents are incorrect or fraudulent, the applicant will be disqualified.
 - (3) Eligible applicants for the Interview, Knowledge Test and Dental Special Skill Test are under the Committee's consideration for the Admission in the Doctor of Dentistry program (International Program), Direct Admission by the Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University, and Academic Year 2026.
 - (4) Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University will collect information of applicants. The faculty will keep applicants' data for one year and six months for statistical analysis and research to improve quality and processes and to confirm application evidences.

5. Examination methods and admission criteria for Students (both Groups 1 and 2)

5.1 The shortlist candidates for the dental special skill test and interview are considered based on:

5.1.1 Academic knowledge test (*Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry*) 100%

5.2 The criteria for student admission consist of the following:

5.2.1 Academic knowledge test (*Biology, Biochemistry, Chemistry*) 30%

5.2.2 Dental special skill test 30%

5.2.3 Interview (*conducted in English*) 30%

5.2.4 Portfolio and statement of purpose 10%

Remarks: Admission consideration is at the discretion of the MIDS Admission Committee for the Doctor of Dentistry program (International Program), direct admission by the Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University, Academic Year 2026.

6. Confirmation of enrollment

6.1 Accepted applicants with Thai nationality and accepted applicants with non-Thai nationality must confirm the enrollment at Mahidol International Dental School (MIDS), Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University at a given date and time. For Thai applicants who do not confirm, the Faculty of Dentistry will not send the applicant's name to a clearing house system.

6.2 Accepted applicants from the waiting list must confirm the enrollment at Mahidol International Dental School (MIDS), Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University at a given date and time. (If accepted applicants are not confirmed within the specified period, the Faculty of Dentistry will not notify applicants from the waiting list in case there is someone waives the right to attend this program.)

6.3 Accepted applicants with Thai nationality must confirm the enrollment through a clearinghouse system scheduled by TCAS at www.mytcas.com by choosing only 1 selected field of study. When there is a confirmation within the specified period, it will be considered that those are enrolled and cannot apply for the next application round. (If applicants do not confirm their eligibility within the specified period, it will be considered as a waiver, and cannot claim any rights later.)

6.4 Waiver of rights to study in the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program, Doctor of Medicine Program, and Doctor of Pharmacy Program at any public higher education institution, applicants will not be able to apply for the same program at any public higher education institution for the next application round.

6.5 Waiver of .../-13-

- 6.5 Waiver of rights must be done in the TCAS system only and cannot be revoked later. Notification of waiver of rights at the university without waiving rights in the TCAS system within the specified time is not considered a waiver of rights in the TCAS system, the applicant cannot reapply for the next application round.
- 6.6 In case there are some accepted applicants who waive the right of attending this program, accepted applicants from the waiting list must not confirm or not use rights in the TCAS system.

7. English language proficiency assessment criteria

Undergraduate students must pass the English Proficiency Assessment criteria before graduation according to the conditions and criteria set by the university. This is considered as one of the qualifications for degree approval according to item 20.4, which is one of the criteria for the degree approval as defined in the Mahidol University Regulations on the Diploma and Bachelor's Degree B.E. 2559 or amendments and announcements of Mahidol University on the Standard of English Language Proficiency of Undergraduate Students, Mahidol University B.E. 2566.
