on Student Admission
Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program)
(Faculty of Dentistry - Mahidol University International College Collaboration)
Direct Admission by Faculty, Academic Year 2026

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The Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University is now accepting applications for the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program), (Faculty of Dentistry - Mahidol University International College Collaboration), Faculty of Dentistry, Direct Admission by Faculty, Academic Year 2026. Pursuant to Section 37 of the Mahidol University Act, B.E. 2550 (2007). The details are hereby announced as follows:

1. Total admission: 3 people

2. Admission requirements

2.1 General eligibility requirements

2.1.1 Applicants are current students for the last trimester of the academic year 2025 or graduated with the Bachelor of Science (Major in Biological Sciences) from Mahidol University International College.

Note: Applicants, currently studying in the last trimester, must be able to enroll in the first semester of the DDS program academic year 2026.

2.1.2 Applicants must earn at least 22 credits of basic sciences and mathematics.

2.1.3 Applicants must earn minimum C grades in basic sciences and mathematics.

2.1.4 Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) greater than or equal to 3.25.

2.1.5 Non - Thai applicants must have a passport of the country in which applicant holds citizenship. The passport must be valid for six months beyond the last day of application period. Applicants must be prepared to obtain a visa to enter Thailand for the interview and to undergo a medical examination on the specified date and time.

2.1.6 Applicants must possess good health and free from the following diseases, symptoms, or physical deformities that hinder the study and practice of dentistry:

2.1.6.1 Serious.../-2-

2.1.6.1 Serious psychiatric problems that may be harmful to oneself and/or others include psychotic disorders, mood disorders, personality disorders (antisocial personality disorders or borderline personality disorders types), and other psychotic disorders.

2.1.6.2 Communicable diseases within an active condition that could harm oneself, patients, or could result in permanent disability.

2.1.6.3 Have non - communicable diseases or conditions that could harm oneself and/or others and could be an obstacle to the study and practice of dentistry.

2.1.6.4 Physical deformities that could be an obstacle to study and practice of dentistry.

2.1.6.5 Hearing impairment of both ears with hearing threshold higher than 40 decibels at 500 - 2000 Hz. frequency and speech discrimination score less than 70 percent of sensorineural hearing loss.

2.1.6.6 Visual impairment with the best eye when corrected with glasses has visual acuity less than 6/12 or 20/40.

2.1.6.7 Total color blindness that could be an obstacle to study and practice of dentistry.

2.1.6.8 Other illnesses or disabilities not specified here but could be an obstacle to study and practice of dentistry.

Note: Accepted applicants must submit a medical clearance form and the examination results as specified by the Faculty of Dentistry. For the diseases, symptoms, or physical deformities listed in section 2.1.6, the decision is at the discretion of the Faculty Committee and is considered final.

3. Application process and required documents

3.1 Applicants are required to carefully review the details in the admission announcement (Applicants should study the information independently for their own benefit).

3.3 The application form must be filled out completely as required and signed with a blue ink pen.

3.4 A 1.5 x 2-inch, front-facing photo, wearing a university uniform (hats and sunglasses are not permitted) with a white or blue background and must be taken less than 6 months and not digitally modified. **(Attach your photo on the application form)**

3.5 A photocopy of identification card **(use only the front)** OR a photocopy of passport and must be signed with a blue ink pen. In case, the applicant's name or last name presented on the ID card or the passport **does not match** with other documents. The applicant must have a certified copy of name changes and must be signed with a blue ink pen.

3.6 A photocopy.../-3-

3.6 A photocopy of the house registration for Thai applicants OR a photocopy of proof of residence in Thailand for non - Thai applicants and must be signed with a blue ink pen.

3.7 A photocopy of university diploma must be signed with a blue ink pen OR a certificate of graduation (**original one**) from Bachelor of Science (Major in Biological Sciences), Mahidol University International College OR a certificate of student status for current students who are expected to graduate in academic year 2025 from Bachelor of Science (Major in Biological Sciences), Mahidol University International College. (**original one**)

3.8 A certified letter for applying the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program) must have the signature of registrar or an authorized person with a MUIC seal (**original one**) (applicants can contact Assistant Professor Dr.Tumnoon Charaslertrangsi, Chair of Science Division).

3.9 An official transcript (**original one**)

3.10 A photocopy of an official TOEFL OR TOEIC OR IELTS score must be signed with a blue ink pen. (**optional**)

3.11 A Statement of purpose should explain the reason and motivation for applying in Doctor of Dental Surgery program (International Program) and life goals, at least 500 words, using Time New Roman, 12 font size and single space.

3.12 A Curriculum Vitae (CV) including personal information, extracurricular activities, etc. within one A4 page.

3.13 Applicants are required to pay the full application fee of 3,500 Baht. Payment must be made in person at any branch of **Siam Commercial Bank only (online transfers are not accepted)**. The depositor's name must be the applicant's name. The payment must be completed by **Wednesday, March 25, 2026, at 4:00 p.m.** Applicants must submit the **original** payment receipt issued by the bank only. MIDS reserves the right not to refund the application fee under any circumstances and will not be responsible for any transfer fees or exchange rate charges. - 5.2 Dental special skill test scores 30%
- 5.3 Interview scores (The interview will be conducted in English.) 30%

Note: Eligible applicants for the Dental Special Skill Test and Interview are at the discretion of the Faculty Committee of the Faculty of Dentistry, Mahidol University.

6. English competence standards for Undergraduate student of Mahidol University

Undergraduate students must pass the English Proficiency Assessment criteria before graduation according to the conditions and criteria set by the University which is one of the criteria for the degree approval as defined in the Mahidol University Regulations on the Diploma and Bachelor's Degree or amendments and announcements of Mahidol University on the Standard of English Language Proficiency of Undergraduate Students, Mahidol University B.E. 2023, announced on 20 December, 2023 and edited version.
